MERCHANTS' COUNCIL CORNER

Parking

The Tarrytown Merchants' Council will hold a meeting on Sept 13th at 9:00 AM at Main St Café to discuss parking solutions for downtown merchants.

With Wachovia Bank closing, there has been concern that the village will lose their agreement to allow for public parking when the bank is not open. The Tarrytown village administrator, Steve McCabe, has been in touch with Wachovia Bank and has assurances that the agreement will continue until the building is sold.

Signage

The Signage Committee will meet again in September to discuss improving the signage in the Tarrytown district.

Valet Parking

A final decision on the Valet Parking has been delayed. The representative from the Valet Parking Company has been ill. A meeting is planned for September and we hope to have an announcement by November.
